Product Stewardship Policy Statement

Fraser Surrey Docks is committed to sustainable Product Stewardship. We will take an active role in ensuring the proper disposal and recycling of all end-of-life products used at our facility. FSD will promote sound Product Stewardship practices that assume environmental, health, and safety protections of designated products and the end-of-life product management.

FSD continues to be involved in and enforces the following existing stewardship programs:

1. Electronic and electrical, fluorescent lamps and batteries, smoke detectors, thermostats, cell phones, batteries are to be collected by Maintenance or IT Department and placed in the designated container for disposal.
2. Small appliances are to be collected by Maintenance or IT Department and placed in the designated container for disposal.
3. Large appliances, electrical and electronic tools, monitoring and control instruments, IT and telecommunications equipment are to be collected by Maintenance or IT Department and placed in the designated container for disposal.
4. Paints/Spray Cans/Solvents and flammable liquids cans are to be placed in the appropriate marked bins placed around the Terminal and picked up by a designated and certified contractor.
5. Used lubrications and fuels such as oil and antifreeze along with filters, rags and absorbents are to be placed in the appropriately marked containers for disposal by a designated and certified contractor.
6. Used lubrication containers and drums to be placed in the appropriately marked containers or bermed areas for disposal by a designated and certified contractor
7. Empty food, beverage containers and packaging are to be recycled in the blue bins provided to each facility on the Terminal
8. Tires - as replaced they are to be taken away by our tire contractor to be disposed of properly
9. Metal Recycling is to be separated and placed into designated metal recycling bins provided by the metal recycling company
10. All paper utilized on dock is to be collected in the blue bins provided to each facility on the Terminal and collected by a responsible recycling contractor.
11. All cardboard utilized on dock is to be collected in the blue bins provided to each facility on the Terminal and collected by a responsible recycling contractor.
12. All dunnage and wood products utilized on dock is to be collected in the yellow bins provided at numerous locations on the Terminal and collected by a responsible recycling contractor.
