Reporting to the Manager, Maintenance & Terminal Service, you are responsible to achieve a safe, effective and cost efficient Maintenance department

Responsibilities:

Supervision:

- Responsible for crane/diesel shops and maintenance of facilities and the day-to-day performance of these areas
- Ensure daily operating targets are met as effectively and cost efficiently as possible
- Supervises foremen and maintenance personnel
- Identify areas that require corrective action and implement safe cost effective solutions
- Provide leadership and direction for maintenance staff to carry out of their day-to-day duties (supervise, instruct, motivate)

Health & Safety:

- Attend weekly toolbox talks and address items required
- Responsible for creating safe work areas, safe work practices, safe tools, and organize all pertinent training for the personnel to perform their job duties safely
- Set-up controls, processes, procedures and systems as required exercising their functions and responsibilities safely
- Review and audit controls on a regular basis
- Responsible for maintaining WHMIS compliance and systems for maintenance departments
- Coordinate safety management through regular safety inspections and actively participating in weekly and monthly safety meetings

Relationships:

- To maintain and improve relationships with ILWU

General Duties

- Assist in preparation of annual budget by providing maintenance/facilities targets, associated labour requirements and improvements
- Work on special assignments and projects as required
- Create and maintain schedule for adequate supervision on all working/stand by shifts
- Assist in the procurement of supplies, suppliers, contractors and consultants as the facility and operations require
- Liaise with operations on a daily basis to ensure all equipment issues are addressed and all facility assets remain at optimal operating conditions
